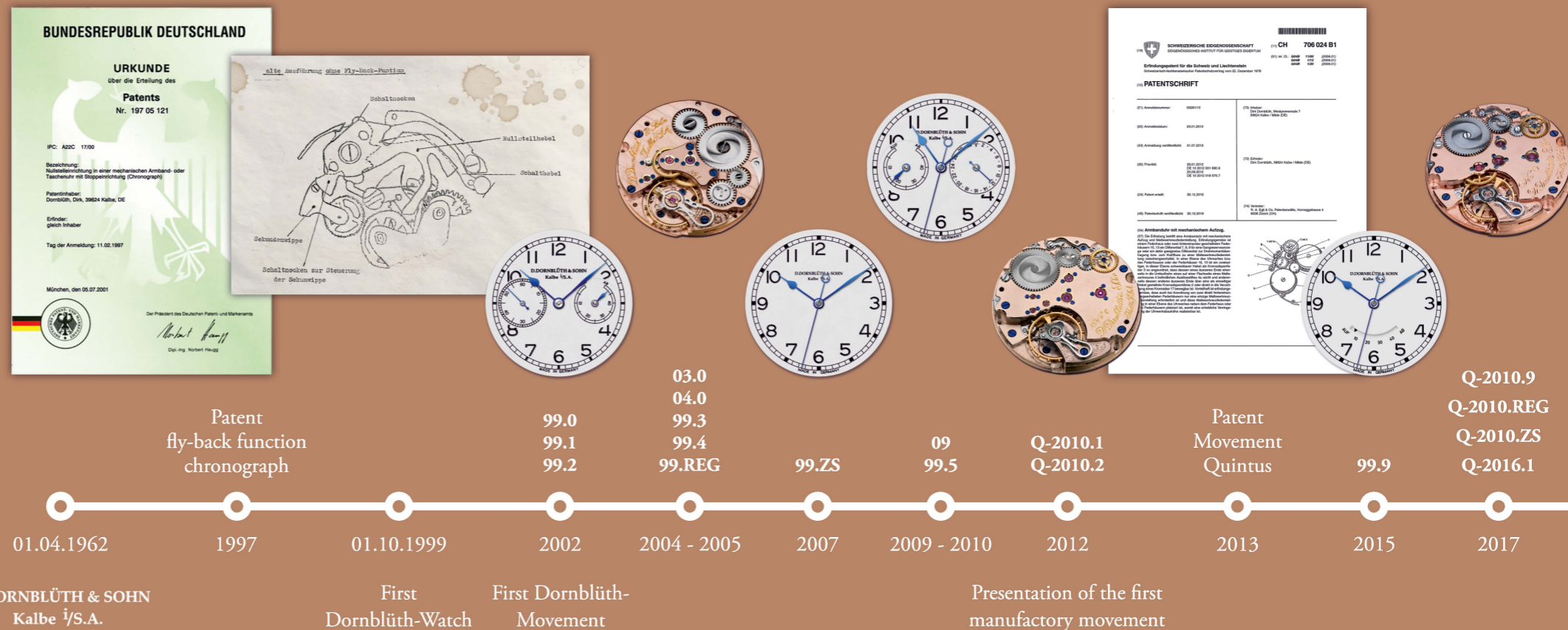
### A tradition of precision and innovation: 25 years of manufactory

The history of the Dornblüth manufactory began in 1962, when Dieter Dornblüth opened his small watch workshop. With a passionate pursuit of precision and craftsmanship excellence, he laid the foundations for a manufactory that today stands for luxurious timepieces.

In 1983, his son Dirk Dornblüth joined the company, bringing with him a breath of fresh air and new ideas. Seven years later, in 1992, Dirk became a master watchmaker - a decisive milestone on his way to continuing his father's vision.

This was followed in 1997 by the manufacture's first patent, which emphasised the innovative and technical sophistication of the brand. When father Dornblüth celebrated his 60th birthday in 1999, his son Dirk, presented him with a stainless-steel wristwatch of his own design, the basic movement of which was based on the legendary Glashütte Calibre 60.3.

Today, after 25 years, Dornblüth is synonymous with exclusive, handmade watches that combine tradition and progress.'

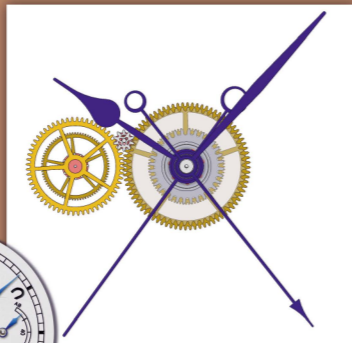

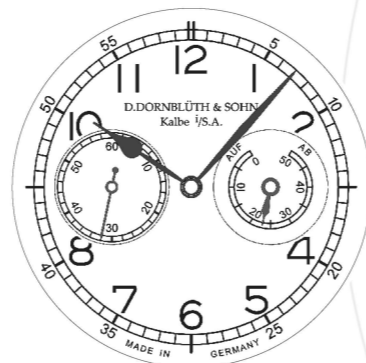

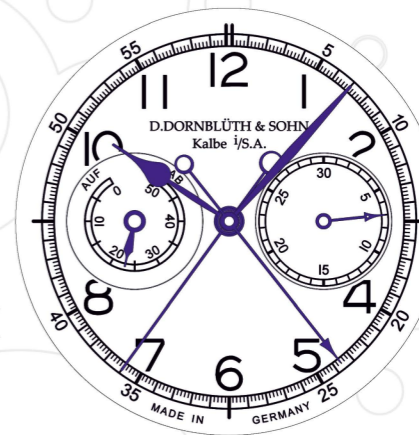

What takes a long time finally becomes good.

The idea of developing a chronograph had been around since 1997. After the 99.2 saw the light of day in 2002, Dieter and Dirk Dornblüth thought about developing a chronograph with a combination of power reserve and fly-back function. Over the years, they worked constantly to achieve the perfect result. Many of the ideas collected by Dieter and Dirk Dornblüth have now been realised 27 years later.





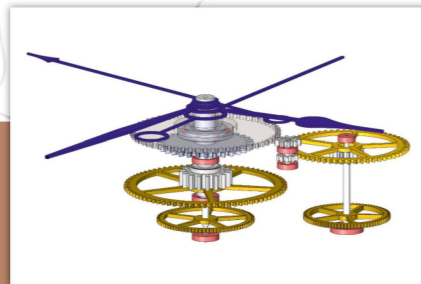
The newly developed movement under the realisation of the 1997 patent is a hand-wound chronograph with a 30-minute counter and a fly-back function. The movement has rhodium-plated grained bridges and cocks with yellow gold-plated hand engraving of the company name and movement number as standard.

**Limited edition**

This exclusive model is limited to 62 pieces - a tribute to the founding of the manufactory by Dieter Dornblüh in 1962.

Now, 62 years later, this limited edition epitomises the timeless combination of tradition and innovation.

Each piece embodies the craftsmanship and passion that have been cultivated in the manufactory for decades.
